

RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING DR STEFAN KRÓL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

1. The Scholarship Fund is established from a donation of PLN 17,994.24 (seventeen-thousand nine hundred ninety-four Polish Zloty and 24 Polish Grosz) made by Ms. Marianna Król to The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL).
2. The aforementioned donation amount shall be placed in a long-term bank account providing high interest rate.
3. Interest from the account shall be used for student Scholarships.
4. The maximum of two (2) Scholarships shall be awarded in a given academic year, reaching no more than PLN 3,000 (three thousand Polish Zloty) altogether. Scholarship is paid from Fund capital in case the interest accrued does not suffice for payment.
5. Scholarships shall be awarded to outstanding students of KUL who are Polish nationals or who hold a valid Pole's Card. The eligibility criteria include:
 - (a) academic record for the previous year of study,
 - (b) artistic achievements that contribute to promoting KUL in Poland and abroad,
 - (c) extraordinary engagement in the matters of KUL that contributes to promoting KUL in Poland and abroad,
 - (d) opinion from the relevant Dean
6. Fund can also be utilized to support students in difficult life circumstances, depending on the decision of Vice-rector competent for student support.
7. Decision to award Scholarship shall be made by the Commission for Funded Scholarships, chaired by the Vice-rector competent for student support.
8. Scholarship applications are processed by no later than 31 December. Scholarship holder writes a gratitude note to the Funder no later than 14 day from being informed of awarding Scholarship.
9. Scholarship may be withdrawn by Vice-rector competent for student support in the event of:
 - (a) suspension of students' rights;
 - (b) reprehensible attitude with disrespect to Catholic ideals;
 - (c) withdrawal from studies at KUL;
 - (d) failure to complete a semester or an academic year;
 - (e) removal from the list of students or relegation from KUL;
 - (f) graduation of Scholarship holder.
