RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING JOHN ROY-WOJCIECHOWSKI SCHOLARSHIP FUND

- 1. The Scholarship Fund is established from following financial resources:
- a donation of NZD 5,000 (five thousand New Zealand Dollars) made by John Roy-Wojciechowski Honourable Consul of the Republic of Poland to New Zealand to The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL) ("The Founder"). The aforementioned donation amount shall be placed in a bank account.
- annual donations to the Fund,
- dedicated write-offs from the Founder's assets,
- other donations.
- 2. Interest from the account referred to in Point 1 and/or other donations shall be used for Scholarships.
- 3. Scholarships shall be awarded on a motion by Rector of KUL to outstanding students of the full-time students of the course: History.
- 4. The academic record from the previous stages of study shall be Scholarship eligibility criterion.
- 5. Scholarships shall be awarded from the second year of study onwards. Scholarship may be withdrawn in the event of failure to complete a semester or an academic year, or on withdrawal from studies.
- 6. Decision to award Scholarship shall be made by the Commission for Funded Scholarships, chaired by Vice-rector competent for student support, on a prior opinion from Vice-rector competent for research and international cooperation.
