

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING ABP. WALENTY DYMEK SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

1. The Scholarship Fund is established from a donation of PLN 27,000 (twenty-seven thousand Polish Zloty) made by Rev. Prelate Jan Śliwański – representative of Polish Chaplaincy in Hamburg, Germany – to The John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin (KUL).
2. The aforementioned donation amount shall be placed in a long-term bank account providing high interest rate.
3. Interest from the account shall be used for Scholarships.
4. Scholarships shall be awarded to outstanding students of the Faculty of Theology at KUL from lower-income family backgrounds.
5. Scholarships shall be awarded from the second year of study onwards. Scholarship may be withdrawn in the event of failure to complete a semester or an academic year, or on withdrawal from studies.
6. The decision to award Scholarship is made by the Commission for Funded Scholarships, chaired by Vice-rector for student support.
